Go 1 mile to Logonia (Hwy 38) and turn RIGHT.

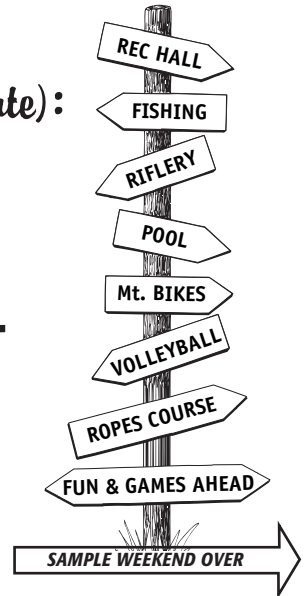
Go 19 miles to Angelus Oaks.

Go 3 miles to Seven Oaks Road (note several mail boxes here) turn RIGHT.

Go just over 1 mile on the dirt road to Wasewagan Camp & Retreat.
